Specifics:

Spend 2 1/2 - 3 hours removing trash and debris from the creek/levee area of the West Silver Eagle site at Steelhead Creek, as well as removing invasive non-native plants. Garbage bags will be provided.

What to wear:

It is recommended that all volunteers wear comfortable/washable clothes: **sturdy shoes**, long pants, and **scouts = red activity shirt**. (You may want to bring a light weight long sleeved shirt for sun protection), **gloves** (work or gardening type) , hat/sunglasses/sunscreen. *** This will be a dirty job so wear old clothes/shoes that you don't mind getting dirty/muddy, possibly wet.*

Directions:

- From I-80, take Northgate Blvd exit, South.
- Get into Left lane.
- In less than 1 mile, at the San Juan traffic light, make a U-turn.
- Head North 100 feet.
- Turn Right on West Silver Eagle Road.
- Road ends at the creek. There is parking in the neighborhood.
